Why should I become a member of the Crown King Community Association?

If you are a fulltime homeowner, property owner or weekend cabin owner, you will be kept in the loop with all the goings on in Crown King. You will have access to all the up to date town news and have someone to turn to for help if there is an issue regarding the roads, county and forest, etc.

What is the membership fee?

The membership fee for all homeowners, property owners and cabin owners is \$20.00 per person or voting member – not per household. If there are two adults in the home, the membership fee will be \$40.00
